DUŠAN RADOJEVIĆ

Dr. Dušan Radojević is an Assistant Research Professor in the Probiotics and Host-Microbiota Interaction Group at the Institute of Molecular Genetics and Genetic Engineering (IMGGE), University of Belgrade. He graduated from the Faculty of Biology, University of Belgrade, where he also completed his Master's degree and PhD. During his PhD studies, he investigated the relationship between gut microbiome and the phenotypic and functional variability of in vitro-generated myeloid cells.

He received the "Goran Ljubijankić" Foundation Award for the best PhD thesis in molecular biology and the "Stanka Romac" Foundation Award for the best PhD thesis in human molecular genetics or biomedicine. His research focuses on host-microbiota interactions in health and disease, with particular emphasis on aging, as well as the application of metagenomics and machine learning-based approaches.

In 2025, he spent three months at the University of Naples Federico II as a fellow of the Federation of European Microbiological Societies in the group of Prof. Pasolli. He has participated in several national and international scientific, R&D, and innovation projects and has served on the organizing committee of two international conferences.
