Liviana Ricci is a Postdoctoral Researcher in the Computational Metagenomics Lab at the University of Trento, Italy. With a background spanning the *in vitro* characterization of bacterial functions and interactions, and metagenomics, her current research focuses on the transmission of non-pathogenic bacteria during early life and the bacterial functional repertoires that contribute to host health. She is primarily interested in the mechanisms driving the assembly and function of the human gut microbiome to support the development of next-generation microbiome-derived therapeutics.
