Miroslav Dinić is a Research Associate Professor at IMGGE, University of Belgrade, whose research focuses on probiotics and the gut microbiome. He received his Ph.D. in Medical Sciences, with a focus on Pharmaceutical Microbiology, from the Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Belgrade. His research focuses on the gut microbiota–brain axis, aging, and age-related neurodegenerative diseases, integrating *in vitro* systems, *Caenorhabditis elegans* models, and translational approaches to identify microbiota-based biomarkers and microbe-derived metabolites with neuroprotective and geroprotective potential. He has completed postdoctoral training as a Fulbright and FEMS fellow at the University of Miami (USA) and at the CECAD Research Center, University of Cologne (Germany), where he specialized in host–microbe interactions and the use of *C. elegans* as a model organism.
