Dr. Yishay Pinto is a microbiome and virome researcher and principal investigator of the Pinto Lab in the Faculty of Life Sciences at Bar-Ilan University, where his group studies human–bacteria–phage interactions. Following postdoctoral training in the Bhatt Lab at Stanford University School of Medicine, he established his lab to integrate metagenomics, experimental microbiology, synthetic biology, and large language models to study bacteriophages as biomarkers, modulators of microbial communities, and direct interactors with human cells and systems, with implications for human health.
